Common Terms:

webinar - a presentation or workshop that is transmitted via the internet. Webinars will have interactive elements - like discussions.

online - an internet browser based training session.

independent study - instructor led, where lessons and assignments are given and participants work independently, but there is regular contact with the instructor.

hybrid - a blended session that includes face to face (or webinar) instruction with online or independent study activities.

Modes of Learning:

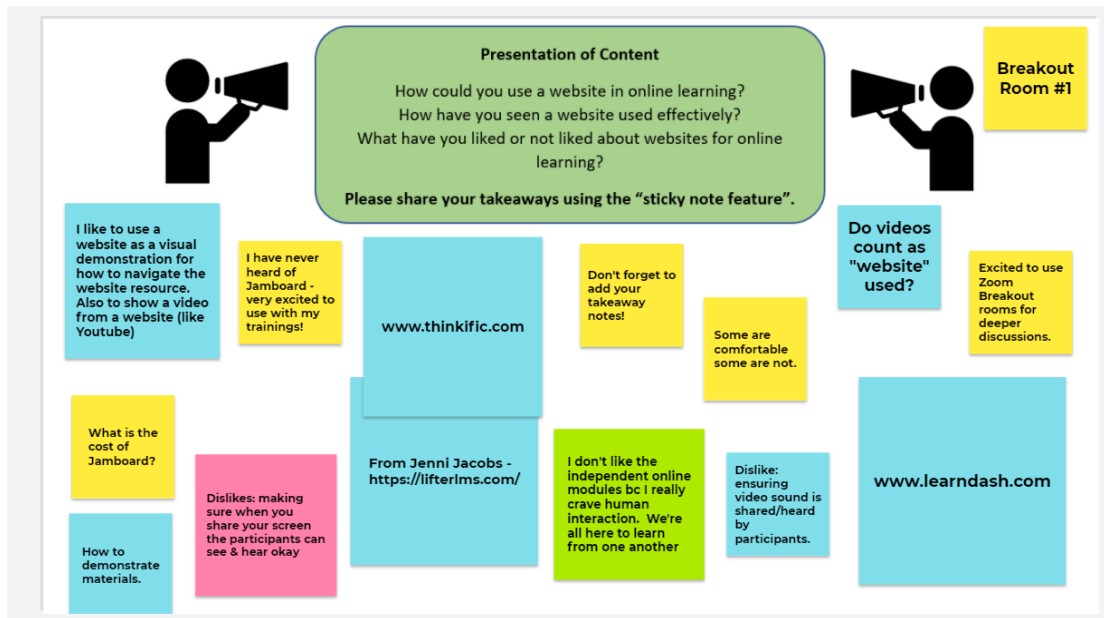
mini-lecture, demonstration, brainstorm, classroom observation, written assignment, case study, handouts (to be completed), discussion boards, games, videos with questions, reading with questions, role play, poster activity, etc.

What is a Learning Management System (LMS)

An LMS is a platform (typically a website) that maintains your trainings and allows users access to it.

An LMS is not required for online training, but some things to keep in mind, if you choose to have one:

- What is the cost/fee?
- Do they accept payments for me?
- What type of security is in place for personal information.
- Is it useable on mobile and desktops?
- Who owns the content once it is placed on the LMS?
- What type of content can be put on the LMS?



Entering Data into ECE-TRIS

As the trainer you follow all regulations pertaining to online learning.

However, YOU are able to decide what is required for completion of the course, in order to receive credit. And, if applicable, when it is due.

Webinar - similar to a face to face session in that there is a specific day/ time to be present for credit.

Hybrid - All components must be completed prior to credit being issued.

Online/Independent Study - information is input into ECE-TRIS, prior to the session. A "shell" is created where credit is issued as participants complete session.
